Although, this Court is of the opinion that it could continue to be fair and impartial to the parties in this litigation, a judge has the obligation under Canon 1 of the *Ohio Code of Judicial Conduct* to avoid even the appearance of impropriety. In the event, this Court made a ruling against the Defendants, the fact the Defendants' law firm is suing family members of the Judge could be raised as a potential ground for an alleged conflict of interest claim.

Based upon the foregoing, this Court hereby gives notice of its voluntary recusal in this case and requests The Ohio Supreme Court assign another visiting judge to preside over this case.
