This matter comes before the Court upon two pending motions. Upon due consideration of each motion and the briefs in opposition filed, the Court makes the following orders:

(1) Plaintiffs’ January 25, 2019 Third Motion to Compel Discovery from the KNR Defendants

Plaintiffs’ Motion to Compel answers to Interrogatory 4-1 and RFP 6-1; Interrogatory 4-3 and RFP 6-5; and Interrogatory 4-4 is GRANTED.

Plaintiffs’ Motion to Compel RFP’s 6-2, 6-3, and 6-4 is OVERRULED.

(2) Plaintiffs’ February 14, 2019 Motion to Compel the Production of KNR Settlement Agreements with Robert Horton and Paul Steele, and Motion for Protective Order regarding KNR’s Confidentiality Agreements with its Employees is GRANTED.¹ The information and communications about the information at issue are subject to the Court’s September 12, 2017 Protective Order.

IT IS THERFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

(1) Plaintiffs’ January 25, 2019 Third Motion to Compel Discovery from the KNR Defendants is GRANTED IN PART AND OVERRULED IN PART;

(2) Plaintiffs’ February 14, 2019 Motion to Compel the Production of KNR Settlement Agreements with Robert Horton and Paul Steele, and Motion for Protective Order regarding KNR’s Confidentiality Agreements with its Employees is GRANTED (as it relates to Paul

Steele). The information and communications about the information are subject to the Court's September 12, 2017 Protective Order.
